ORDER

The Court has before it the State Defendants' "Motion for Clarification of Funding Obligations for the Microbiology Program" at Alabama State University ("ASU"). Docket № 3472. By Order dated October 30, 2006, (Docket № 3477) the Court allowed any party wishing to comment upon or object to


the Agreement to do so on or before November 8, 2006. The only party to file a comment was Alabama State University.

In its response, Alabama State University indicated that it “did not dispute the State Defendants’ interpretation of [the] Court’s November 16, 2005 Order regarding the funding of the [ASU] Microbiology Program.” Docket № 3482 at 1. To that end, ASU does not oppose the relief sought by the State Defendants and agrees that the State is entitled to credit the \$604,232 payment made in support of the program during its initial year of funding, against the remaining funding requirements as Specified in Exhibit A to the State Defendants’ Motion.” Id.

ACCORDINGLY, the State Defendants’ “Motion for Clarification of Funding Obligations for the Microbiology Program” at Alabama State University (Docket № 3472) is **GRANTED**, and the State Defendants are entitled to a credit of

\$604,232 against the remaining funding requirements as
Specified in Exhibit A to the State Defendants' Motion.
